



IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING YOUR TRASH, RECYCLING AND YARD WASTE COLLECTION

Effective the week of August 2, Harrisonville-based GFL will become the residential trash, recycling and yard waste hauler for the city of Harrisonville. **Your weekly collection day will be: SEE MAP.**

Each week, GFL will collect the contents of your 95-gallon trash and 65-gallon recycling carts. Please follow these tips for easy and efficient collection.

- Set materials at the curb by 7 a.m. on your collection day.
- Place carts within 3 feet of the curb, away from other objects and with wheels facing the residence.
- Harrisonville residents can recycle the same mix of paper, cardboard and containers (plastic, aluminum and steel) that they currently recycle. Plastic bags, glass and Styrofoam are **not** accepted. Please make sure materials are loose, clean and dry. **Do not bag your recyclables.**
- You can place up to 12 bags or bundles of yard waste within 3 feet of the curb each week year round.
- Overage stickers for excess trash will be available for purchase by calling GFL customer service at 816-380-5595. Overage stickers are priced at \$7.50 for a sheet of five stickers. Residents can obtain a second trash cart at a subscription cost of \$7.50 per month. Contact our local customer service, 816-380-5595, to arrange cart delivery and billing.
- Construction materials will not be collected in regular waste or bulk item pickup.
- GFL observes the following holidays: Independence Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's Day. If your collection day falls on or after the holiday, your materials will be collected one day late.

Yard Waste Information:

- Yard waste (grass clippings, leaves, plants, small shrubs and limbs less than 2 inches in diameter) must be placed in paper bags not to exceed 50 pounds. Bundled materials must be no more than 4 feet long or 6 inches in diameter.
- Fencing, landscape timbers, flowerpots, yard decoration, mulch, rock, dirt and similar items are *not* considered yard waste and **will not be collected**.

Bulk Item Information:

One residentially generated bulk item per residence will be collected monthly. Bulky items are defined as household items that can be reasonably carried by one or two individuals. Excluded items will not be collected.

- **Bulk items include** couches, chairs, dressers, mattresses, tables, appliances without CFCs, etc.
- **Bulk item collection excludes** electronic waste items such as televisions and computer monitors; hazardous waste; tires and automotive parts; appliances with CFCs; and construction materials.
